We received your correspondence concerning the Interstate Bridge Program on 3/17/2023.

The Oregon Government Ethics Commission only has jurisdiction to enforce the ethics provisions in ORS Chapter 244. Oregon Government Ethics law in ORS Chapter 244 relates to financial conflicts of interest, prohibited use of position or office for personal financial gain, nepotism, and gifts to public officials. These provisions all relate to public officials using their positions for personal financial gain. Also, they apply to individual public officials, not to public bodies.

The information in your submission is insufficient to indicate that any of the laws within ORS Chapter 244 may have been violated. You do not provide information indicating that an identified public official may have violated any of the provisions in ORS Chapter 244.
